


Work June 1 through June 4



# THE RESTORATION TEAM

## OUR PROJECTS START ANYWHERE ON THE FOLLOWING LIST

- ▶Step 1: If a home has not been gutted since the flood, remove all existing sheetrock and insulation
  - ▶Step 2: Remediate the bare studs for mold – scrub down all open wood, and spray with a mold-killing chemical. Paint over each stud with kilz.
  - ▶Step 3: Repair framing where structural damage has occurred
  - ▶Step 4: Upgrade plumbing and electric (we contract this out professionally)
  - ▶Step 5: Repair any damaged exterior siding/paint the exterior of home
  - ▶Step 6: Install vapor barrier/insulation on all exterior walls
  - ▶Step 7: Hang sheetrock
  - ▶Step 8: Tape and float sheetrock
  - ▶Step 9: Paint interior
  - ▶Step 10: Lay floors
  - ▶Step 11: Finish work/trim/cabinets

# COST FOR MISSION TRIP

- ▶ Total cost approximately \$8000 based on 20 people.
  - ▶ Youth pay \$100
  - ▶ First \$50 payment due March 1
  - ▶ Second \$50 payment due April 5
  - ▶ Fundraisers for the rest
