




Daylight Savings Time ends this weekend, so don't forget to set your clocks back one hour before bed Saturday, 11/2.

Join us Sunday, November 3 for Communion and remembering all those who went before us.






URBAN PEAK DONATIONS



Our final gift collection will be at the 10:30 service on **December 8**. After that service, we will deliver the gifts to the Police Department. Along with the gifts, we ask you to pray for the children and their families.

OCTOBER ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS:

- Roger Wise reported that giving is currently at 93% of budget. There are currently 11 families utilizing the ACH program for their giving. Please contact Roger if you wish to sign up to have your pledge/giving done through ACH transfer. The Stewardship Campaign for 2020 will begin at the end of October, pledge cards were included in letters to the congregation and can also be obtained at the church.
- Don Robinson explained that there will be a new way of designating how apportionments will be figured for 2020. 10% will go to the Conference and 3% will be allocated over eight different funds at Good Shepherd's discretion. Please check the conference website for the description of the various funds. Ad Board will continue working on this at a future meeting.
- Garage steel replacement doors are on order and the security cameras are being upgraded for remote access.
- The Ad Board voted on and approved that Reverend Lin return as our Pastor. The required paperwork will be sent to the Conference office.
- We voted and approved that \$1000.00 be sent to Global Hope for their mission. We also voted to add \$1000.00 to the church budget to support Global Hope going forward.
